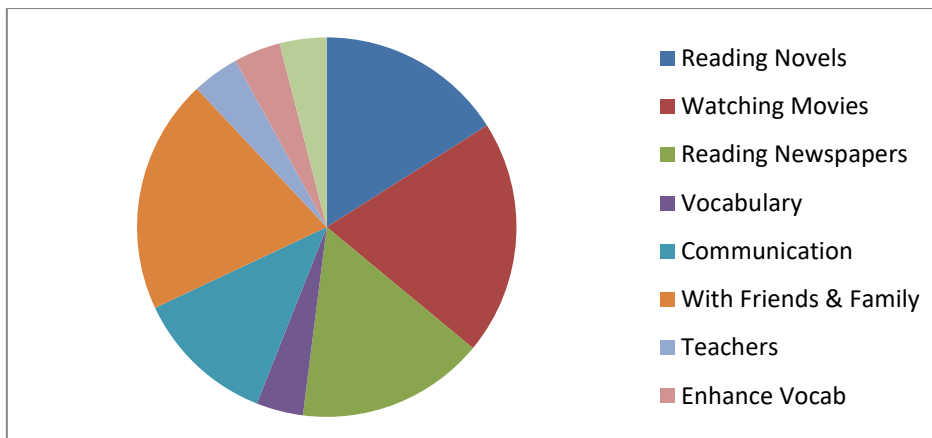

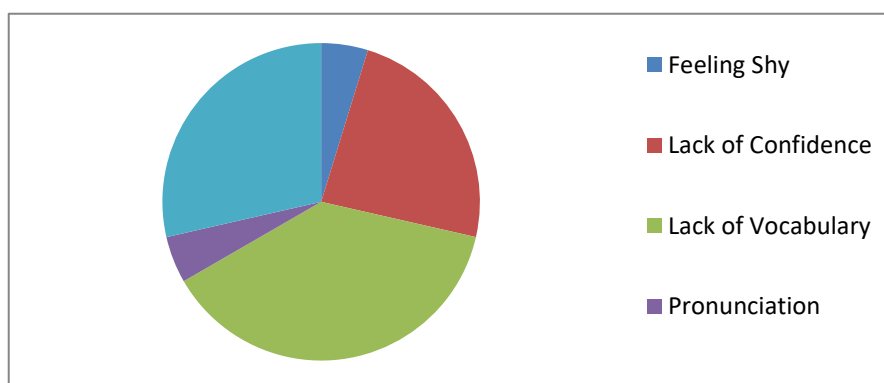

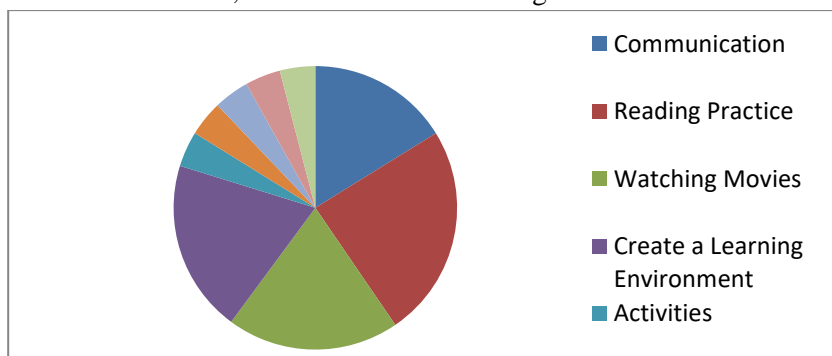

This will motivate them to speak more in English.

### Conclusion

The analysis of data collected through a group of university students of educational administration clearly indicated the difficulties and problems while speaking English. They prefer native language over target language.

The other cause is lack of confidence and afraid of making mistakes.
